On September 6, 2017, the undersigned and Markham Erickson of Steptoe & Johnson LLP met with Nicholas Degani, Senior Counsel to Chairman Pai; Jay Schwarz Wireline Advisor to Chairman Pai; Holly Saurer, Acting Legal Advisor for Media Issues to Commissioner Rosenworcel; Nathan Eagan, Acting Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Carr; and Kristine Fargotstein, William Richardson and Douglas Klein from the Office of General Counsel, regarding the above-referenced proceeding. On September 7, 2017, we also met with Amy Bender, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner O’Rielly, regarding the above-referenced proceeding. At each meeting we discussed the motion filed by INCOMPAS to modify the protective orders in certain prior transaction proceedings, the oppositions to that motion filed by AT&T, Charter, Comcast and Verizon, and INCOMPAS’s responses to those oppositions. In particular, we offered to work with the Commission to gather interested stakeholders and agree on a process for reviewing confidential and highly confidential information in those mergers that are relevant to the issues raised in the NPRM in the instant proceeding, while maintaining the confidentiality of that material. We also reiterated the arguments set forth in INCOMPAS’s filings concerning the Motion.
