On September 11, 2017, Valerie Green, Executive Vice President and Chief Legal Officer of Ligado Networks LLC (“Ligado”) and the undersigned met with Ron Repasi and Paul Murray of the Office of Engineering and Technology; Charles Mathias, Paul Powell, and Aalok Mehta of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Bob Nelson of the International Bureau. The parties discussed the status of the Commission’s proceedings regarding Ligado’s license modification applications and petition for rulemaking to reallocate the 1675-1680 MHz band for shared commercial use. In that connection, we briefed the staff on our ongoing efforts to address Iridium’s stated concerns and our discussions with key stakeholders. We also reiterated the point made by multiple parties in the record that the Commission has ample evidence to find that approval of the license modifications will not cause harm to GPS device users and will be in the public interest.
