Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 12, 2017, Samsung's Youngky Kim, DongSoo Park, Mark Louison, Woojune Kim, Robert Kubik, and the undersigned met with FCC Chairman Ajit Pai and Chairman Pai's Policy Advisor Nathan Leamer.

During the meeting, Samsung thanked the Chairman for his leadership in accelerating the provision of 5G services in the mmWave bands. Along those lines, Samsung stressed the importance of mmWave spectrum to US leadership of 5G services. Samsung also reiterated the importance of removing barriers to infrastructure deployment to facilitate 5G in mmWave bands and small cell deployment, and urged action by the FCC along these lines.

In addition, Samsung briefed Chairman Pai and Mr. Leamer on its plans in the 3.5 GHz Citizens Broadband Radio Service and urged the FCC to issue final approval of Spectrum Access System Administrators in a timely fashion.
