Dear Mr. Fishel:

On behalf of CELSAT, Inc., this is to convey its informal objection to the disclosure of the substance of an *ex parte* oral presentation on October 27, 1992, made by counsel for TRW, Ellipsat, Constellation Communications, and Loral/Qualcomm to Gerald P. Vaughn, Deputy Bureau Chief, Operations. In a brief, one paragraph written disclosure filed pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, the substance of that meeting was summarily described with the following representation:

"The presentations made reiterated the substance of Comments previously filed by the parties with the Commission."


CELSAT submits that such a terse description of an oral *ex parte* presentation falls far short of meeting the requirements of the Commission's disclosure rules under Section 1.1206 and, indeed, constitutes an abuse of the *ex parte* privilege. Accordingly, this is to request that the Managing Director and/or Mr. Vaughn convey to the parties involved that they have not satisfactorily met their obligations under the rule and direct that a more complete and accurate disclosure be filed.
