Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 12, 2019, David Field, Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of Entercom Communications Corp. ("Entercom"), and Sarah Harris, Entercom's Vice President of Social Impact, met with Chairman Pai and his Media Advisor, Alexander Sanjenis, to discuss certain issues raised in the above-captioned proceedings.

They discussed the FCC's 2018 Quadrennial Regulatory Review and reiterated our support of the proposals set forth by the National Association of Broadcasters to modify the local radio ownership rule. They also noted our filing of joint reply comments in the docket.

During the meeting, they also expressed our concern that certain of the modifications to the LPFM technical rules proposed in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in MB Docket No. 19-193 could bring increased congestion to the FM dial leading to interference to full power stations.

Finally, they noted our support of the Commission's proposal to modernize the rules related to the written and on-air public notices that broadcasters must provide upon the filing of certain applications.
