Dear Ms. Dortch:

OpenBand of Virginia, LLC ("OpenBand") respectfully withdraws the above-referenced application that sought Commission authority to discontinue telecommunications services provided to customers in the Southern Walk at Broadlands subdivision ("Southern Walk") in Loudoun County, Virginia. Filed on June 26, 2019 pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act and Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, the application sought authority for OpenBand to discontinue service on or about August 31, 2019.


Since filing its application, however, the Southern Walk customers to whom OpenBand was providing telecommunications services have either migrated to another provider or made other arrangements for their communications needs. As a result, OpenBand currently has no existing customers for telecommunications services at Southern Walk. Nor has OpenBand received any requests for telecommunications service at Southern Walk in the preceding 30-day period. Under the circumstances, and consistent with the Commission's *Forbearance Order*, service discontinuance approval is not required under Section 214(a) or Section 63.71.¹ Accordingly, OpenBand respectfully withdraws the above-referenced service discontinuance application.
