On Friday, September 13, 2019, the undersigned of the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) spoke via telephone with Al Shuldiner, Chief of the Audio Division of the Media Bureau, concerning the draft Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (FNPRM) in the above-captioned proceedings.¹

During the call, I observed that it might be more appropriate and consistent with consumer expectations for online notices to appear at a tab or link that states, "Pending FCC Applications" (or something similar), rather than placing the full text of the notice on a station's home page.² I also stated that NAB appreciates the significant streamlining and harmonization of many aspects of the rule proposed in this draft.
