To whom it may concern:

We hereby appeal USAC's Appeal Denial Dated 9-6-2018, which pertained to USAC's Funding Commitment Decision Letter ("FCDL") dated April 21, 2018, which approved FRN 1899066361. Due to a ministerial/clerical error, consultant filed the FRN for the wrong vendor and the wrong monthly recurring cost. Applicant first became aware of this issue on August 16, 2018, when Knight Nets, Inc. - Applicant's current and proper internet provider - contacted Applicant just prior to preparing its first invoice for services since the Funding Year began on July 1, 2018. Applicant or consultant could not reasonably have known of the error prior to that contacts from the vendor and, therefore, did not file for this change until this time.

Applicant asks that the FRN be modified to reflect the actual and correct vendor Knight Nets, Inc., SPIN 143007392, instead of Charter Communications Operating, LLC, SPIN 143050436, and that the FRN be further modified to reflect the actual and correct monthly recurring cost (pre-discount) of \$675.00 per month, rather than \$240.00 per month (pre-discount).

In light of the ministerial/clerical errors described above, USAC should allow modification of FRN 1899066361 as set forth above. Thank you for your consideration of this matter. We attach invoices from Knight Nets, Inc. – the actual and correct provider – showing the service

provided in Funding Year 2017, and the current service during Funding Year 2018. Please let us know if you require any additional documentation or materials.
