RE: Filing outside of the Window

We were not aware that we were filing outside of the window. We were instructed by our PIA to redo the 471 form in order to show the Category 1 and Category 2. He did inform us that we would be outside of the filing window. However, he told us that **"we intend to review the new application as if it was received within the FY2018 FCC From 471 filing window. (Please ignore the FCC form 471 Postmarked Outside of Window letter you may receive for the new application would see that it was outside of the filing window but he would correct it on his side." (See attachment OUTSIDE WINDOW).**

We have been waiting and trying to contact him in reference to the Category 1 and Category 2. We filed everything under Category 2 on February 27, 2018. 12:22:03 EST in error. (See application # 181014182). We were told to go back and re-submit the Form 471. After he got the new form 471, he would cancel out this form and enter the correct 471 Category 1 and Category 2.

We then attempted to submit the second 471 Category 1 and 2 and received a missing data error and what not able to submit. Customer Service assisted us and told us to cancel it out and submit again.

We then submitted the third and final 471 (181043207 Category 1) and 181043208 Category 2) on August 10, 2018 17:16:13 EDT. We have been waiting to hear from our PIA. Each time we call it goes to the voice mail. I then called Customer Service today to see why we have not heard from USAC.

We were waiting for a funding respond not knowing that we were out of compliance. No one told us until today to do a waiver request.
