Sonic.net is only charging me \$62.93 for high speed internet(899Mbps) service and a landline whereas Comcast was charging me about \$70.00 for internet service only at 100Mbps. Otherwise, there would not be any improvement in consumer service. Competition also keeps price of internet service low.
