On September 15, 2017, Rubén Cabellero, Mohit Nahang, Mark Neumann, Sarah Herrlinger, Tim Powderly, Maria Kirby, and Jason Lundgaard of Apple, Inc. met with Commissioner Brendan Carr and his Acting Legal Advisor Kevin Holmes. They discussed Apple's commitment to accessibility innovation for its customers, and, separately, the need for additional spectrum resources to support wireless technologies. Apple commended the FCC for initiating the Mid-Band Spectrum Notice of Inquiry, and encouraged the Commission to open the 3.7 GHz band for licensed services and the 6 GHz band for unlicensed services.
