Pursuant to Section 1.1206(b) of the Commissions’ Rule, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), notice is here provided of *ex parte* communications in the above-captioned docket. On September 18, 2018, Peter Ewens, Executive Vice President, Corporate Strategy of T-Mobile US, Inc.
