On September 19, 2016, Charles McKee of Sprint Corporation and I met with Stephanie Weiner, Legal Advisor to Chairman Wheeler; Matthew DelNero, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau; and Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. We discussed that the FCC's pending Business Data Services (BDS) order should address mechanisms for expedited BDS challenge proceedings and the effect of changed BDS rules on existing and new BDS agreements. We also discussed that the Commission should not delay implementation of BDS rules, as some BDS providers have recently argued.
