**REQUEST FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENT**

1. The LPFM Coalition ("LPFM Coalition"), through counsel, hereby requests leave ("Request for Leave") to supplement its Reply to Comments on the "Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" in the above-captioned proceeding ("NPRM") to amend Part 74 of the Commission's Rules Regarding FM Translator Interference ("Supplement").<sup>1</sup>
2. The LPFM Coalition filed the Supplement simultaneously with this Request for Leave via the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System ("ECFS").
3. Approval of the Request for Leave serves the public interest by (1) correcting another commenter's mis-statements of fact placed on the record of this proceeding and (2) helping the Commission ensure such mis-statements do not lead to improper rulemaking outcomes that would slow ultimate resolution of stated NPRM issues.
4. As the Supplement is filed directly to the electronic record of this proceeding, no party's rights would be abridged by a grant of this Request for Leave. As the Supplement is also submitted shortly after the close of the reply period to the NPRM's initial comments, grant of leave will not cause undue administrative burden.
