MIP IV MidWest Fiber, LLC (“MIP IV MW”) hereby notifies the Commission that the above-referenced transfers of control of domestic Section 214 authorizations held by PEG Bandwidth IL, LLC (“PEG IL”) and Missouri Network Alliance, LLC (“MNA”) were consummated on August 30, 2019.

Immediately after closing, MIP IV MW implemented a non-substantive, *pro forma* transfer of control involving PEG IL. PEG IL had been a direct subsidiary of MIP IV MW upon the consummation of the approved transaction, and after the *pro forma* restructuring is now a direct subsidiary of Bluebird Network LLC (“Bluebird”), which itself is a direct subsidiary of MIP IV MW. MNA is also a direct subsidiary of Bluebird.
