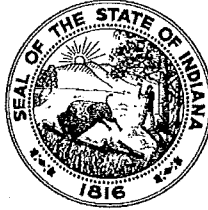

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 54.314, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) hereby certifies to the Federal Communications Commission and the Universal Service Administrative Company that the telecommunications carriers included in the attachment to this letter (Attachment A) are eligible to receive federal high-cost support for the program years cited.

The IURC certifies for the carriers listed that all federal high-cost support provided to such carriers within Indiana was used in the preceding calendar year (2016) and will be used in the coming calendar year (2018) only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended.¹

¹ 47 C.F.R. § 54.314(a) (“Certification. States that desire eligible telecommunications carriers to receive support pursuant to the high-cost program must file an annual certification with the Administrator and the Commission stating that all federal high-cost support provided to such carriers within the State was used in the preceding calendar year and will be used in the coming calendar year only for the provision, maintenance, and upgrading of facilities and services for which the support is intended. High-cost support shall only be provided to the extent that the State has filed the requisite certification pursuant to this section.”)
