The independent telephone company submitting these comments supports the Commission's efforts to develop the regulatory scheme that will permit rapid implementation of advanced wireless personal communications services in the United States. However, we strongly urge the Commission to ensure that the requirements adopted in this proceeding promote, rather than inhibit, the provision of PCS in rural America.


Accordingly, we support the comments filed by Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company, et al requesting the following modifications to the rules proposed by the FCC:

- Establish smaller PCS license areas for rural PCS.
- Grant rural PCS licenses at the request of rural LECs servicing areas with populations of 10,000 or less.
- Refrain from handicapping LECs from providing PCS in rural areas and/or specifically exempt rural telcos servicing areas of 10,000 or less from any restrictions generally imposed on LECs.
- Impose minimal regulations on PCS providers.
- Permit cooperative rural telephone companies to elect private land mobile status for their PCS offerings.
