

COMMENTS

FCC - MAIL ROOM

1. By Notice of Proposed Rule Making in the above-captioned proceeding, 7 FCC Rcd 7570 (1992), the Commission gave notice of a proposal by J.J. Taylor Companies, Inc. ("Taylor") to reallocate channel 294C1 from Leesburg, Florida, to Tavares, Florida, and to modify the license of Taylor's station WXXL(FM) accordingly. Taylor, by its attorney and pursuant to Rules 1.415 and 1.420, hereby comments in support of its proposal.

2. Technical issues. The Notice of Proposed Rule Making stated that the proposed Tavares reference point is short-spaced to a pending application (BPH-891129IB) for station WDFL-FM, Cross City, Florida. Taylor would note that (1) the Tavares reference point is the presently licensed site of WXXL, and (2) the WDFL-FM

application specifies facilities under Rule 73.215 that are fully consistent with WXXL's operation at the proposed reference site with full class C1 facilities, as proposed.

3. Section 307(b). Taylor has previously shown that Tavares is a distinct community with its own government, businesses, civic organizations and other institutions, fully warranting a local transmission service under Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

4. Tavares' importance as the seat of Lake County has been underscored by the recent determination that Lake County meets criteria for inclusion in the Orlando Metropolitan Statistical Area, effective January 1, 1993. (This change does not alter Leesburg's and Tavares' status as lying outside Census-defined urbanized areas.)

5. Continued interest. Finally, Taylor hereby reaffirms its interest in this proposal, and its intention to promptly file an appropriate application to implement the change once it becomes effective.


6. Conclusion. As set out in its original petition for rule making and herein, Taylor's proposal complies with the Commission's

technical requirements and would result in a preferential arrangement of FM allotments. Taylor therefore urges the Commission to amend the FM Table of Allotments as proposed in this proceeding.
