AT&T California is hereby providing notification that it is declaring Force Majeure events in the state of California. These declarations are in conjunction with the California gubernatorial service emergency declarations posted on January 23, 2017.

As noted in the declarations, the effective date for the first of these events was determined to be December 9, 2016. These Force Majeure events are the result of the fall and winter storm systems that began sweeping across the state of California beginning in October 2016. These systems brought high winds, substantial precipitation, and flooding, which has severely impacted counties throughout the State. Due to extreme drought conditions already existing, this storm system also caused dangerous flash flooding, erosion, and substantial mud and debris flows; and caused damage to roads and highways throughout the State.

These weather conditions have negatively impacted AT&T's ability to perform at normal response intervals, delayed installation and repair functions, and may result in standard due dates not being available during the event. Consistent with normal business practices and to the extent possible given the conditions, AT&T California will conduct operations during this Force Majeure event in a nondiscriminatory manner, including performing all restoration and repair activities.

This event had a negative impact on AT&T's performance under your wholesale Interconnection or commercial agreement (the "Agreement") and any applicable performance plans and constitutes a Force Majeure event as defined in your Agreement. AT&T California reserves all rights consistent with applicable state and federal law and with the relevant Force Majeure terms in your Agreement and any applicable performance plan. AT&T California will provide subsequent notice via Accessible Letter when operations have returned to normal conditions and the Force Majeure events are lifted.
