Dear Mr. Begley:

This is in response to the petition for rule making which you filed on behalf of Minnesota Christian Broadcasters, Inc., requesting the substitution of Channel 261C3 for Channel 261A at Pequot Lakes, Minnesota, and modification of the license for Station KTIG.

Our engineering analysis indicates that Channel 261C3 cannot be allotted to Pequot Lakes in compliance with Section 73.208(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules. The transmitter site you specify 13.7 kilometers (8.5 miles) south of the community (46-28-54 and 94-20-15) is located in Gull Lake.

Should you decide to refile the petition for Pequot Lakes, you should provide a showing that a transmitter site is available on land that meets the spacing requirements set forth in Section 73.207 of the Commission's Rules.

Accordingly, we are returning your petition.
