and Eliminate Unlawful Robocalls**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 2, 2017, Alex Quilici, CEO of YouMail, Inc. and the undersigned met separately with:

- 1) Amy Bender, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael O'Rielly.
- 2) Zenji Nakazawa, legal advisor to Chairman Ajit Pai.
- 3) Eric Burger, Chief Technology Officer.
- 4) Travis Litman, legal advisor to Commissioner Jessica Rosenworcel.

During these meetings YouMail discussed how its intelligent enhanced services apps and platform are used to stop unwanted robocalls. The company estimated that its patented technology has stopped more than one billion robocalls. YouMail uses various databases, customer feedback and smart algorithms to classify calls as high, medium and low risk; with customers always having the option to white list wanted callers. The YouMail service works with wireless carriers and VoIP providers that expose conditional call forwarding.

YouMail's Robocall Index is used by the FCC and others to determine robocall quantities nationally and locally. For example, YouMail estimated that 2.5 billion robocalls (including 15.9 million calls in area code 202 alone) were placed nationwide in June 2017. The company offered to work with the Commission on resolving robocall complaints.
