Dear Ms. Searcy:

AT&T has made the following modification to its December 23, 1992 Dialing Instructions Communication Plan:

1. By mid-February, AT&T plans to introduce a new 800 number which will allow customers direct access to AT&T's card and operator services. The new number will be included in all customer material issued in connection with the Communications Plan.
2. All AT&T proprietary cardholders as of December 16, 1992 will receive stickers imprinted with the new dialing instructions beginning mid-February. AT&T cards issued after mid-March will contain the new dialing instructions. Customers who are issued cards between December 16 and mid-March will receive stickers in April, 1993.
3. All AT&T Universal Card customers will receive plastic sleeves imprinted with the new dialing instructions beginning mid-March. In addition, all call active card holders will receive replacement cards containing the new dialing instructions beginning mid-April. Two thirds of these cards will be issued within three months and the remainder within six months.
