**REPLY TO
OPPOSITION TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

Edward R. Stolz II (Stolz), by his attorney, hereby respectfully submits this Reply to the Opposition to Petition for Reconsideration filed by Entercom Communications Corporation (Entercom) in the above-entitled matter on October 25, 2017. In so doing whereof, the following is shown:

1. It occurred to the undersigned that Entercom has an obligation as a publicly traded corporation to make filings with the Securities and Exchange Commission relative to various activities and occurrences which affect its operating assets.

2. The undersigned attempted a search of various SEC filings made by Entercom since the designation of the KDND license renewal application for hearing, but could not find any details on the KDND matter. Perhaps the undersigned missed something; as someone who does not practice before the SEC, this is quite possible. If so, the undersigned apologizes.

3. Therefore, the undersigned invites Entercom to file with the FCC the filings it made with the SEC, if any, relative to KDND, and, particularly, relative to the accounting and economic effects the cancellation of the KDND license on the financial position of Entercom.


4. With that information, the FCC would be able to evaluate whether Entercom's voluntary return of the KDND license for cancellation would be an adequate administrative penalty for its behavior in the death of Jennifer Lea Strange.

5. Were Entercom not to have made such a submission or submissions to the SEC, FCC would have a public interest obligation to demand that Entercom make such submissions before the FCC closes the book on the above-entitled action.

WHEREFORE, Edward R. Stolz II urges that the foregoing Petition for Reconsideration **BE GRANTED**, the **MO&O**, FCC 17-114, **BE VACATED**, and additional proceedings ordered relative to Entercom Communications Corporation consistent with this Petition.


