These TV ads are run at all hours - including when children are watching. A warning seconds before the begins is hardly adequate for parents. A small child will not understand the warning. Further, the parent might not be in the room - or even in the house. The candidate could be required to publish a warning in the local newspaper well in advance so that parents have the opportunity, as they do with all other scheduled television programs, to exert some control over what their children are exposed to.




