HERE'S WHY I OBJECT TO THESE ADS HARMFUL TO PEOPLE

I believe the airing of these TV spots presents a clear and present danger of inflicting harm upon my children and others in this community. In their statement to the FCC, joining our complaint, The Colorado Women Psychologists organization has this to say:

"It is our belief that these ads may be potentially harmful, particularly to children and certain populations of women: women who may have recently aborted, experienced a miscarriage or stillbirth, are experiencing an unwanted pregnancy..."

"Seeing an image of a fetus in the particular context and with the emotional delivery which is displayed in these ads may make a vivid impression and traumatize some children."

There's No Warning

These TV ads are run at all hours - including when children are watching. A warning seconds before the ad begins is hardly adequate for parents. A small child will not understand the warning. Further, the parent might not be in the room - or even in the house. The candidate could be required to publish a warning in the local newspaper well in advance so that parents have the opportunity, as they do with all other scheduled television programs, to exert some control over what their children are exposed to.

Warnings Not Necessary

We can convince people to eat vegetarian food - if we choose - without showing the slaughter of a cow, screaming in agony, on TV. We can teach children to cross the street




