On Thursday, November 2, 2017, Christopher J. Murphy, Associate General Counsel, Regulatory Affairs, ViaSat, Inc. ("ViaSat"), Amy Mehlman, President, Mehlman Capitol Strategies, Inc., and the undersigned, had separate meetings with the 8th floor legal advisors listed below.

In these meetings, ViaSat expressed its general support for the draft order proposed for consideration at the November open meeting, and also urged greater flexibility in the deployment of protected earth stations whose emitted power flux density (PFD), measured at 10 meters above ground level, of greater than or equal to -77.6 dBm/m2/MHz, would occur entirely within an area controlled by the earth station licensee.
