SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Bresnan Digital Services, LLC (“Bresnan Digital”), through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, hereby files this Application on behalf of its affiliates Bresnan Broadband of Colorado, LLC, Bresnan Broadband of Montana, LLC and Bresnan Broadband of Wyoming, LLC (collectively, the “Bresnan Companies”) to discontinue offering certain telecommunications and interconnected VoIP services in Colorado, Montana and Wyoming (the “**Service Areas**”).

In support of its Application, Bresnan Digital submits the following information:

Names and address of carriers:

This Application is submitted on behalf of Bresnan Broadband of Colorado, LLC, Bresnan Broadband of Montana, LLC and Bresnan Broadband of Wyoming, LLC. The address for all of the Bresnan Companies is:

Date of planned service discontinuance:

The Bresnan Companies intend to discontinue offering the services described in this Application on December 21, 2017, or as soon thereafter as federal approval may be obtained.

Points of geographic areas of service affected:

Bresnan Broadband of Colorado, LLC currently offers the services that are the subject of this Application in parts of the State of Colorado. Bresnan Broadband of Montana, LLC currently offers the services that are the subject of this Application in parts of the State of Montana. Bresnan Broadband of Wyoming, LLC currently offers the services that are the subject of this Application in parts of the State of Wyoming.

Brief description of the type of service affected:

The Bresnan Companies intend to discontinue offering Basic Local Exchange Service to new business customers. The Basic Local Exchange Service provides a basic local voice line to business customers. The Bresnan Companies have no business customers that are currently purchasing the Basic Local Exchange Service, and the Bresnan Companies have decided to no longer offer this service in the states in which they operate. Similar services are available in the Service Areas from other telecommunications carriers and interconnected VoIP providers, including services offered by the Bresnan Companies' interconnected VoIP service affiliate.

Second, the Bresnan Companies intend to discontinue offering Bresnan Hosted IP Office Service to new and existing customers. The Bresnan Hosted IP Office Service is a hosted interconnected VoIP service provided to business customers by the Bresnan Companies. The Bresnan Companies have a total of twenty-one (21) customer accounts purchasing the service. Similar services are available in the Service Areas from other telecommunications carriers and

interconnected VoIP providers, including services offered by the Bresnan Companies' interconnected VoIP service affiliate.

Third, the Bresnan Companies intend to discontinue offering resold CenturyLink Time Division Multiplex ("TDM") circuits to new and existing customers in the Service Areas. The Bresnan Companies have a total of one hundred twenty nine (129) business customer accounts that would be affected by the service discontinuance. Fifty-seven (57) additional business customer accounts associated with E-Rate recipients will be grandfathered and not discontinued. Similar services are available in the Service Areas from other telecommunications carriers and interconnected VoIP providers.

Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers:

The Bresnan Companies mailed written notice to affected customers on November 6, 2017. Copies of the notices are attached at Exhibits "A" and "B" hereto.

Non-dominance of the carrier with respect to the services to be discontinued:

The Bresnan Companies are non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

Service:

In accordance with Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, Bresnan Digital has mailed copies of this Application to the Governors of the States of Colorado, Montana and Wyoming, the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, the Montana Public Service Commission, the Wyoming Public Service Commission and the United States Secretary of Defense.

Conclusion

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of the offering of these services because comparable services are available from

other providers in the market. Bresnan Digital respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Section 63.71 Application of the Bresnan Companies to discontinue offering Basic Local Exchange Service, Bresnan Hosted IP Office Service, and CenturyLink Time Division Multiplex circuits, as described herein, in Colorado, Montana and Wyoming.
