On November 6, 2018, Valerie Green, Executive Vice President and Chief Legal Officer of Ligado Networks LLC (“Ligado”), and the undersigned met with Umair Javed, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Rosenworcel; Will Adams, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Carr; and Erin McGrath, Legal Advisor to Commissioner O’Rielly, and Kagen Despain, intern to Commissioner O’Rielly. On November 8, Ms. Green and the undersigned met with Rachael Bender, Legal Advisor to Chairman Pai. During the meetings, the parties expressed support for the draft Waiver Order and also discussed the importance of the provisions in the draft Waiver Order that make clear Galileo receivers will not be entitled to protection from reception of signal energies outside of the radionavigation-satellite service allocation. *See e.g.*, Draft Order ¶¶ 21, 41. The parties also discussed how these provisions will help to ensure GPS devices are robust and resilient. Ligado urged the Commission to maintain this language enunciating important spectrum management principles.
