Pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 63.01 through 63.04 of the Commission's rules, U.S. Connect, LLC. ("US Connect"), through undersigned counsel, hereby requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA") from the Bureau for a period of 60 days to allow it to continue to operate while the pending 214 Domestic Transfer of Control application on behalf of U.S. Connect, LLC, Great Wireless, LLC, Patricia Gabrysiak, and Porter USA Enterprises, Inc. is completed.

Licensee is a non-dominant telecommunications carrier holding blanket domestic Section 214 authorization from the Commission to provide interstate telecommunications services under Section 63.01 of the Commission's Rules.

US Connect, the holder of the 214 Domestic/International authority, seeks Commission approval of a transaction which resulted in a transfer of assets which did not received prior FCC approval.

Additional details regarding the application are enclosed as Attachment 1.

US Connect hereby acknowledges that the grant of this STA request will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the underlying application seeking Commission approval of their 214 Domestic application. The parties further acknowledge that this STA can be revoked by the Commission upon its own motion without a hearing.
