**REPORT AND ORDER**  
**(Proceeding Terminated)**

Adopted: January 29, 1993; Released: February 17, 1993

By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

1. The Commission has before it for consideration the *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, 7 FCC Rcd 7563 (1992), issued in response to a petition filed by Frank P. Befera ("petitioner"). The *Notice* proposed the allotment of Channel 299A to Proctor, Minnesota, as that community's first local broadcast service. Petitioner filed comments reaffirming his interest in the allotment of Channel 299A at Proctor. No other comments were received.

2. We believe the public interest would be served by allotting Channel 299A to Proctor, Minnesota, as it will provide the community with its first local broadcast service. Channel 299A can be allotted to Proctor consistent with the minimum distance separation requirements of the Commission's Rules without a site restriction.<sup>1</sup> Since Proctor is located within 320 kilometers (200 miles) of the U.S.-Canadian border, concurrence of the Canadian government has been obtained for this allotment.

3. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in Sections 4(i), 5(c)(1), 303(g) and (r) and 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Sections 0.61, 0.204(b) and 0.283 of the Commission's Rules, IT IS ORDERED, That effective **April 5, 1993**, the FM Table of Allotments, Section 73.202(b) of the Commission's Rules, IS AMENDED for the community listed below, to read as follows:

Community	Channel No.
Proctor, Minnesota	299A

4. The window period for filing applications will open on **April 6, 1993**, and close on **May 6, 1993**.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
