By the Commission: Commissioner O’Rielly issuing a statement.

1. Pursuant to sections 254(a)(1) and 410 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ the Commission appoints the Honorable Brendan Carr, Commissioner of the Federal Communications Commission, to serve on the Federal-State Joint Board on Universal Service (Universal Service Joint Board) and the Federal-State Joint Board on Jurisdictional Separations (Separations Joint Board). Commissioner Carr replaces the Honorable Ajit Pai, who vacates his positions on the Universal Service Joint Board and the Separations Joint Board.

2. In addition, Commissioner Carr and the Honorable Jessica Rosenworcel become members of the Federal-State Joint Conference on Advanced Services (Advanced Services Joint Conference) by virtue of their positions on the Commission.²
