Lismore Cooperative Telephone Company hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering broadband internet transmission service as a separate component of its broadband internet access service. Effective January 1, 2020 Lismore Cooperative Telephone Company will only provide the transmission component as part of the complete broadband internet access service pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order.<sup>1</sup> The geographic areas affected are Lismore Cooperative Telephone Company Study Area 361419.

Today, this service is provided to Lismore Cooperative Telephone Company's non regulated ISP. As stated in the attached customer notice, Lismore Cooperative Telephone Company will only provide the transmission component as part of the complete broadband internet access service (Private Carriage) effective January 1, 2020.


Dear Valued Customer:
