Woodstock Telephone Company hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering broadband internet transmission service as a separate component of its broadband internet access service. Effective January 1, 2020 Woodstock Telephone Company will only provide the transmission component as part of the complete broadband internet access service pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order.<sup>1</sup> The geographic areas affected are Woodstock Telephone Company Study Area 361510.

Today, this service is provided to Woodstock Telephone Company's non-regulated ISP. As stated in the attached customer notice, Woodstock Telephone Company will only provide the transmission component as part of the complete broadband internet access service (Private Carriage) effective January 1, 2020.
