Dear Ms. Dortch:

New Lisbon Broadband and Communications, LLC (NLBC) hereby submits its request for 5 year final certification of compliance for the Rural Broadband Experiments. As required by the rules of the trials program, NLBC has successfully completed all of its fiber network build and is capable of providing fiber-based Internet and voice service to 100% of the living units contained in the census blocks included in the program (attached). The purpose of this letter is to certify completion of the project so that the Letter of Credit obligation can be terminated.

As additional supporting documentation, attached is the original proposal that was submitted for the Rural Broadband Experiments, dated November 5, 2014 and the final approval for the release of funds to NLBC, dated May 4, 2016. I would also add that NLBC is already providing 10 x 1 Mbps or greater service to all these census blocks and, as of January 1, 2019, we will be offering fiber based symmetrical services of 25 x 25, 50 x 50, 100 x 100, and 100 x 100 Mbps in all these census blocks.

Please let me know if there is any additional information needed by your office to complete this final certification.
