Dear Ms. Dortch,

Per FCC Rule 1.1206, this letter provides notice that on November 13, 2019, Stephen Spengler, Chief Executive Officer, Intelsat US LLC; and Gregg Elias and Jennifer Hindin of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel to the C-Band Alliance ("CBA"), met with Chairman Pai and Aaron Goldberger, advisor to Chairman Pai.

During the meeting, the CBA participants discussed the benefits of their proposal to clear, on a nationwide basis, 300 MHz (inclusive of a 20 MHz guard band) of C-band spectrum for terrestrial 5G use via a market-based mechanism. The CBA participants also explained that the market-based mechanism is the fastest means to ensure expedited 5G roll-out while protecting the existing content distribution ecosystem upon which nearly 120 million American households rely.
