Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 51.329(b), Verizon hereby submits an amended version of the Public Notice of Copper Retirement Under Rule 51.333, Copper Retirement ID No. 2019-03-A-MD (“Notice”) that we filed on September 3, 2019. The Notice announced the planned retirement of copper facilities in 82 wire centers in Massachusetts.

We are removing the Sharon (SHRNMAHI) wire center from the Massachusetts Notice, and accordingly we are filing the attached Amended Notice listing the 81 wire centers remaining.¹ We will also post the Amended Notice on our website and ensure that account managers have accurate information.

As the Amended Notice removes one wire center and does not add any new wire centers; and as the Commission has not yet issued its Public Notice, this amendment will not adversely impact any interested party.

Description of the planned network change(s):

Verizon intends to retire the copper facilities at all remaining locations in the eighty-one (81) wire centers listed above. Verizon has deployed or plans to deploy its fiber-to-the-premises network in these areas and intends to provide services over a fiber network infrastructure. Updating our network from copper to fiber benefits our customers because of fiber's resiliency and reliability, especially in inclement weather. Fiber also provides our customers with expanded capabilities to grow with current bandwidth demands for their home or business.

Description of reasonably foreseeable impact(s) of the planned change(s):

After the retirement of the copper facilities, Verizon will: (1) no longer offer services over copper facilities; and (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities. To help ensure an orderly transition, Verizon may require customers and interconnecting entities to migrate services off of copper facilities well before the copper retirement implementation date.
