On Wednesday, February 17, 1993, at 10:00 a.m., the undersigned along with Mark Weinstein, Edward Schor, and H. Gwen Marcus, all of Viacom or one of its subsidiaries, met with William Johnson, Alexandra Wilson, James Coltharp, Diane Hofbauer, Bruce Romano, Rosalee Chiara and Jane Halprin of the Commission's staff. The discussion related to Viacom's comments and reply comments filed in response to the Notice of Proposed Rule Making in MM Docket No. 92-265, FCC 92-543 (rel. Those provisions deal with the development of competition and diversity in video programming distribution and carriage.


