On November 13, 2019, Declan Byrne of the WiMAX Forum, Mark Settle of Wilkinson Barker Knauer LLP, and the undersigned met with Charles Mathias, Roger Noel, and Jeff Tobias, all of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, regarding the above-referenced docket. Mr. Byrne and I also met separately with Aaron Goldberger, Wireless and International Advisor to Chairman Ajit Pai.

During the course of the meetings, the Forum representatives discussed the growing momentum and demand for AeroMACS. The Forum representatives stressed the need for final rules to facilitate further progress and discussed the public interest benefits of a flexible, light-touch regulatory approach for this service as described in the Forum's comments¹ and reply comments.²
