

EXHIBIT 1

INTERESTS IN BROADCAST STATIONS/APPLICATIONS

Donald L. Jones, president/treasurer/director/50% voting shareholder (33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % equity owner) of the applicant herein, has construction permits for low power television stations to serve the communities of Daytona Beach, Cocoa Beach, Titusville, Sebastian, and St. Augustine, all Florida. He is also president/director/50% shareholder of Turner County Broadcasting Company, licensee of WNNQ(AM), Ashburn, Georgia. Although Mr. Jones currently holds an ownership interest in the physical assets used in the operation of WAOS(AM), Austell, Georgia, an agreement has been reached which provides for the sale of his interest therein. Consummation of the above transaction has not yet occurred. Mr. Jones has no ownership interest in the licensee of the Austell, Georgia, facility.

Mr. Jones individually is an applicant for a new FM construction permit for Bolingbroke, Georgia (BPH-900530ME) and Smithville, Georgia (BPH-910503MP). He is vice president/director/33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % shareholder of White City Broadcasting, Inc., applicant for a new FM station to serve the community of White City, Florida (BPH-890914NP). He is 1/3 equity owner as limited partner in Jupiter Broadcasting Limited Partnership, an applicant for a new FM station to serve the community of Jupiter, Florida (BPH-890914NK). He is 51% general partner of Coosa Radio Partnership, applicant for a new FM station to serve Coosa, Georgia (BPH-900226MC). His sister, Joyce Ware, is 49% general partner of Coosa Radio Partnership. Finally, Mr. Jones is president/director/50% voting shareholder (50% equity owner) of Genesis Broadcasting Corporation, applicant for a new FM station to serve Warner Robins, Georgia (BPH-900518MS). A joint request for approval of settlement agreement providing for the grant of the application of Genesis Broadcasting Corporation is now pending before the FM branch.

Applications filed by Mr. Jones for construction permit for new low power television stations on Channel 67 at Jacksonville, Florida (BPTTL-891207QI) and Channel 31 at New Smyrna Beach, Florida (BPTTL-890309RN) were dismissed as a result of the Commission's selection by lottery of competing applicants for the above facilities. An application filed by Mr. Jones for construction permit for a new low power television station on Channel 23 at West Palm Beach, Florida (BPTTL-891207QG) was returned by the Commission on March 20, 1990 due to technical deficiencies in the application.

William H. Sanders has the following interests:

- a. 5% shareholder, Director and Secretary of Downs Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of Station WAFX(FM), Prattville, Alabama;
- b. Licensee of Station KDXR(FM), Borger, Texas;¹
- c. Director of Jones Intercable, Inc., a company which owns and operates cable systems in Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida,² Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia and Wisconsin;
- d. Secretary, Treasurer, Director and 80% stockholder of Martin Media, Inc., general partner of CalValley Radio Limited Partnership, licensee of Station KVFX(FM), Manteca, California;

¹Sanders currently has pending an application for renewal of license of station KDXR.

²Jones Intercable, Inc. does not operate a cable television system in the same area proposed by the applicant herein. Such a cable system is operated, however, by Jones Spacelink, Ltd., an affiliated company not under the control of Jones Intercable, Inc. Consequently, Mr. Sanders does not vote on matters pertaining to the Panama City Beach, Florida cable television system, directly or indirectly.

e. Vice-President, Director, and 50% stockholder of Radeck Broadcasting, Inc., general partner of Big Sky Broadcasting Limited Partnership, licensee of Television Station KTVH, Helena, Montana;

f. 0.2% shareholder of Turner Broadcasting System, Inc., parent company of licensee of Station WTBS(TV), Atlanta, Georgia;

g. Director and 50% stockholder of CDK Communications, Inc., the corporate general partner of Kentucky Radio Limited Partnership, the licensee of Stations WAXU(AM) and WTKT(FM), Georgetown, Kentucky;

h. 49% stockholder of Picus Broadcasting Corporation, Inc., the licensee of Radio Stations WZAZ-FM, Green Cove Springs, Florida, and WZAZ(AM), Jacksonville, Florida;

i. 85% shareholder, Chairman of the Board and Secretary of Chattanooga Radio, Inc., general partner of Tennessee Communications Limited Partnership, the licensee of Station WNOO(AM), Chattanooga, Tennessee, and WFXS(FM), Soddy-Daisy, Tennessee;

j. Owns less than 0.1% of the stock of various publicly-traded cable MSO's and newspaper owners;

k. Secretary, Treasurer, Director, and 33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % shareholder of KB Media, Inc., applicant for assignment of license of KYEL-TV, Yuma, Arizona (BALCT-910318KE) and applicant for a television translator in connection therewith. The assignment application was granted April 24, 1991, but has not yet been consummated. The translator application remains pending.
