AT&T Florida intends to migrate all communications traffic off the Golden Glades 04T (NDADFLGG04T - 18400 NE 5th Ave., North Dade, FL, 33179) access (InterLATA, Feature Group-D), intraLATA, and local tandem switch. Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

As a part of the migration, each affected interexchange carrier, independent local exchange carrier, wireless service provider, and competitive local exchange carrier (CLEC) must take the necessary steps to reroute existing traffic flow from the **NDADFLGG04T** switch to the **NDADFLGG01T** switch beginning January 1, 2020. All existing trunking to **NDADFLGG04T** will be eliminated on the implementation date, so all necessary and appropriate trunk groups should be established to the **NDADFLGG01T** switch.

Access Service Requests (ASR) or Local Service Requests (LSR) are due to be submitted on or prior to January 1, 2020. End user customers will not be impacted by this network change and will continue to dial 7/10 digits to reach an outgoing destination number. Incoming calls from other customers to the end user will continue to be routed as they are today with no change in billing for services and calls.
