

INTEGRATION STATEMENT

Spectrum Broadcasting Co. ("Spectrum") is the applicant for Channel 288A, Bowdon, Georgia. It is a Georgia partnership, consisting of two partners, Tana D. Stalnaker and James Wylly Watts, Jr.

Tana D. Stalnaker, 50% partner in Spectrum, will serve full-time, at least 40 hours per week, as General Manager of the proposed station. She will terminate all other paid employment in order to effectuate that commitment.

As General Manager, Ms. Stalnaker's duties will include overseeing and assuming ultimate responsibility for the day to day activities at the station, with special attention to the sales and news departments. She will also be responsible for overseeing sales to agency and local accounts, hiring of sales and news staff, and managing the Public File and E.E.O. program.

When Spectrum's application is granted, James Wylly Watts, Jr., who also is a 50% partner in Spectrum, will serve full-time as Operations Manager of the station and will work a minimum of 40 hours per week in that capacity. He will terminate all other paid employment in order to effectuate that commitment.

As Operations Manager, Mr. Watts' duties will include overseeing all programming content of the station, supervising and hiring the traffic department personnel, supervising and hiring the on-air production staff, managing the technical operations of the station, representing the station at community events, overseeing the station's public affairs programming, and overseeing its participation in local public affairs and its community relations efforts. In addition, he will be responsible for research and development regarding business and technical decisions concerning this station.

Spectrum will seek enhancement credit by virtue of Ms. Stalnaker's participation in the application by virtue of her gender (female), her proposed future residency in Bowdon, her past broadcast experience, and her past involvement in civic activities which benefitted the community of Bowdon. Ms. Stalnaker's past involvement in civic activities which benefitted Bowdon, which include:

Member, Georgia Senate Music Committee (nominated by Lt. Governor Zell Miller in 1988, renominated by Gov. Zell Miller in 1990)

Republican Delegate for Georgia Republican County
-- Appointed in 1987, and continues to serve as
Delegate to Georgia Republican Party
