Dear Ms. Searcy:

On March 10, 1993, Doug Schoenberger of AT&T met with Alexander Belinfante and Peyton Wynns of the Common Carrier Bureau regarding the above referenced proceeding.

The discussion reiterated AT&T's position that assigning N11 codes as proposed would be an inefficient use of scarce numbering resources. Although any use of these numbering resources should be carefully considered, nationwide applications that serve broad segments of the population are far preferable than those uses currently proposed in the NPRM. The Commission should seek out these types of services, such as that recommended by the National Center for Law and Deafness in its February 3, 1993 *ex parte*, and carefully consider these applications in their decision-making process.
