It has come to my attention that the local CBS-affiliate television station in Kalamazoo aired a number of free spots for a pro-choice organization about three weeks before the general election in response to the paid commercials encouraging adoption sponsored by the DeMoss Foundation. When questioned by Dorothy Talanda, president of Kalamazoo Right to Life, the station manager, Gil Buettner, replied that he had no choice but to provide free air time due to the "Fairness Doctrine" during a political election since abortion was a political issue.

Somehow this doesn't seem right. If one organization pays for commercial time it seems logical that a competing group should have the right to voice an opposing view, provided they pay equally. The DeMoss Foundation commercials focus on adoption, only hinting that abortion is not the best solution to an unplanned pregnancy. These commercials have been running for well over a year and have nothing to do with the election. In fact, the content affords them the opportunity of running the ad year-round. By contrast, the pro-choice commercials focused strictly on abortion.

Is it possible that the FCC look into the matter. The station in question is WWMT-Channel 3. The address is:


