These ads featured aborted fetuses, some dismembered and all very disgusting. Although this is a good way to shock people into seeing your point of view, most people are angered when they see these. This often led to the people not voting for the candidate running these ads.

I also feel that the warning placed on the front of these commercials by some television stations is not effective enough, and many children could possibly be "scarred" by these ads.

Traditionally, these ads would not be run, mostly because the viewing audience and the broadcasters are more conservative. Television stations here in Colorado and other parts of the country have been trying to get these ads off of their daily broadcast during election times.

Some people would say that this is the only way to show others what abortion is really like; however, people around the country don't agree. These tapes are usually readily available at public libraries and abortion clinics nationwide, so if people want to see the effects of
