Federated Telephone Cooperative hereby provides notice that it intends to cease offering broadband internet transmission service as a separate component of its broadband internet access service and Consumer Broadband-Only Loop (CBOL) service Effective January 1, 2020. Federated Telephone Cooperative will only provide the transmission component as part of the complete broadband internet access service pursuant to the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order.¹ The geographic areas affected are Federated Telephone Cooperative Study Area 361390 and 361403.

Today, the broadband internet transmission service is provided to Federated Telephone Cooperative's nonregulated ISP. As stated in the attached customer notice, Federated Telephone Cooperative will only provide the transmission component as part of the complete broadband internet access service via private carriage effective January 1, 2020.
