Dear Secretary Dortch:

On November 9, 2018, parties to the above referenced proceeding filed a Joint Application for Consent to Transfer Control of Domestic and International Authorizations Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as Amended. The Commission docketed the domestic portion of the application on November 13, 2018 in WC Docket No. 18-341. In the application, Thompson Street Capital Partners V, L.P. (“Thompson Street”) and SIP.US LLC (“SIP.US”) sought consent to transfer of control of SIP.US’s Section 214 authorizations to Thompson Street.

After further discussion between counsel for Thompson Street and Commission staff, counsel for Thompson Street has confirmed with SIP.US that SIP.US’s only line of business is interconnected VoIP. Therefore, as discussed with the Commission staff, only an International Section 214 authorization transfer of control approval is required to be obtained and, accordingly, the parties respectfully request that the domestic component of the transfer of control application be withdrawn. The parties further request that the International Bureau and the Commission continue to process the International Section 214 transfer of control application.
