

Dear FCC Chairs,

I understand that you will be voting soon on a plan to repeal Net Neutrality regulations. I want you to know that I strongly support the existing network neutrality principles and encourage you to do the same. I want the internet to remain free and open; to continue to be a place where I can access any lawful content that I want and where folks delivering that content can't play favorites. I am concerned that the quest for profits, corporate interests and the dislike of certain political viewpoints will change both what I can see on the internet and the quality of my connection. Broadband providers should not be able to discriminate against information by halting, slowing or otherwise tampering with the transfer of data. Broadband providers should continue to be treated as a common carrier with the responsibility to treat all traffic neutrally, just like the phone companies. Please do not remove these equivalent rules for broadband internet providers.
