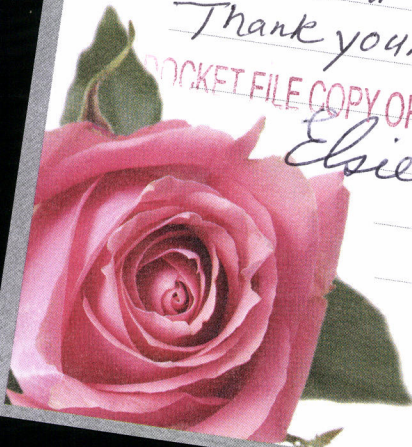

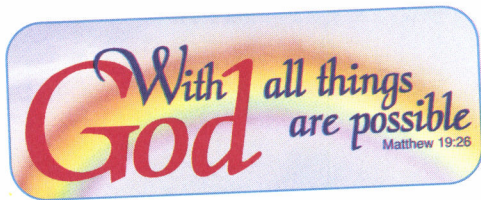
To Who it may Concern,

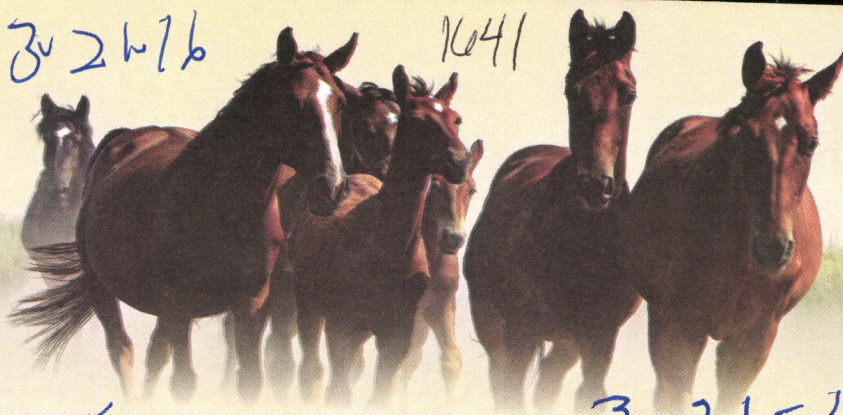
