Re: Notice of Oral Ex Parte Presentation – Securus Technologies, Inc. and Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC d/b/a ICSolutions Consolidated Applications for Consent to the Transfer of Control of Licenses and Authorizations – WC Docket No. 18-193

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 27, 2018, representatives of Securus Technologies, Inc. (“Securus”), Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC d/b/a ICSolutions (“ICS,” and together with Securus, “Applicants”), and Keefe Group, LLC (“Keefe”)¹ met with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC” or “Commission”) Staff listed in Exhibit A from the (1) Wireline Competition Bureau (“WCB”), including Staff from the Office of the Bureau Chief, the Competition Policy Division (“CPD”), and the Pricing Policy Division (“PPD”); (2) International Bureau (“IB”); (3) Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis (“OSP”); and (4) Office of General Counsel (“OGC”) to discuss the status of the above-referenced application.²

The Applicants initially provided a summary of the issues raised in opposition to the transaction and stated their position that these issues had been fully addressed in the record developed to date. Thereafter, at the request of the Staff, the Applicants provided a general overview of the bidding process for inmate telephone service (“ITS”) contracts. Largely in response to questions posed by the Staff, the Applicants discussed, among other things, general bidding requirements in Requests For Proposals (“RFP”) (including basic service components sought therein), the duration of RFP processes, other services offered in conjunction with ITS, such as inmate tablets and contraband cellphone detection, and trends in ITS rates.

The Applicants then also responded to Staff questions concerning certain information submitted by the Applicants in response to Specification 19 in the Commission’s September 11,



2018 Information and Document Requests,³ agreeing to supply further clarifying information in response the Staff's further inquiries as necessary. More specifically, and at the request of the Staff, Securus and ICS confirmed that updates to the Specification 19 data have included only new information since any prior updates and did not change previously submitted data. Representatives for Securus further clarified that in its updates the company has highlighted any new information.


Finally, there was a brief discussion of the status of state approvals for the transaction, potential timing of FCC action, including restarting the Commission's informal 180-day shot clock, and the Public Notice released that day concerning Protocall, LLC and Combined Public Communications, LLC.⁴
