**Re: In the Matter of Petition of USTelecom for Forbearance Pursuant to
47 U.S.C. Section 160(c); WC Docket No. 18-141; Category 1**

Dear FCC,

I strongly urge that USTelecom's request to dismantle key components of the 1996 Telecommunications Act NOT be granted for these reasons:

1. The existence of competing providers, who serve residential customers, voids the trade association's claim that no damage to competition or residential customers, will result.

The truth is there are two other wired Internet providers in my market: Lan Minds and Sonic. USTelecom is well aware of this. UST is asking the FCC to destroy AT&T and Verizon's competitors for them, instead of allowing market forces to determine who we, the customers, prefer.

2. USTelecom has committed conscious fraud by claiming that no competitors or residential customers will be harmed by their request. A fraudulent claim must be denied.

3. Our AT&T service has been poor and we had a complete breakdown of Internet and Phone last week. It took AT&T a week to fix the problem which was in the outside lines, not our house.

4. We have been waiting for Sonic services to reach our neighborhood so that we can have much higher quality internet and cheaper.

AT&T and Verizon impose high prices in markets they dominate. USTelecom must not be granted this false filing to the FCC in order to extort higher prices from Internet users.
